Fewer than 7

Utah has fewer than seven nurses per 1,000 people, one of the lowest in the entire nation.





3000 Positions

There are nearly 3000 unfilled RN positions in Utah, and more than 2500 nursing positions open

1 in 5

1 in 5 Utah nurses are approaching retirement age





Nurse Depletion

From 2020-2021, the nation saw the total supply of RNs deplete by 100,000, the largest we've seen in over 4 decades. In Utah, it was over 1,000 nurses and continues to decline

Retention

52% of Utah nurses are considering leaving their job primarily due to insufficient staffing, work negatively affecting health and well-being, and inability to deliver quality care.
